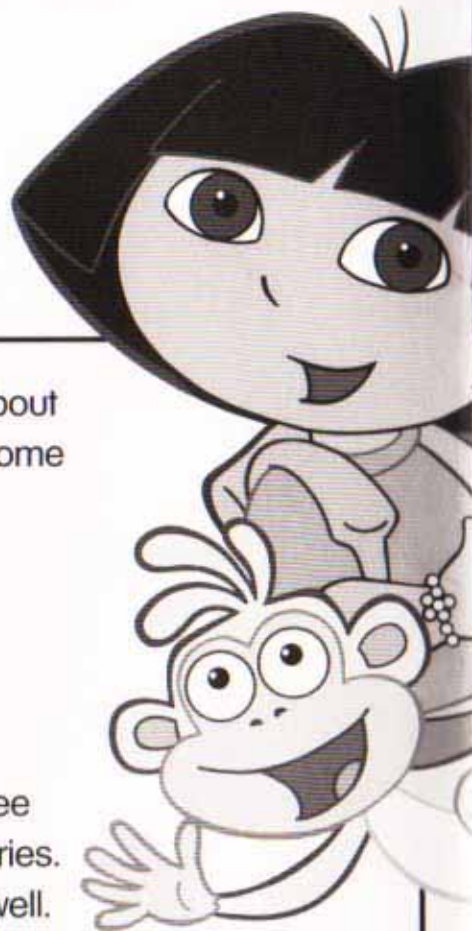

two shooting stars.



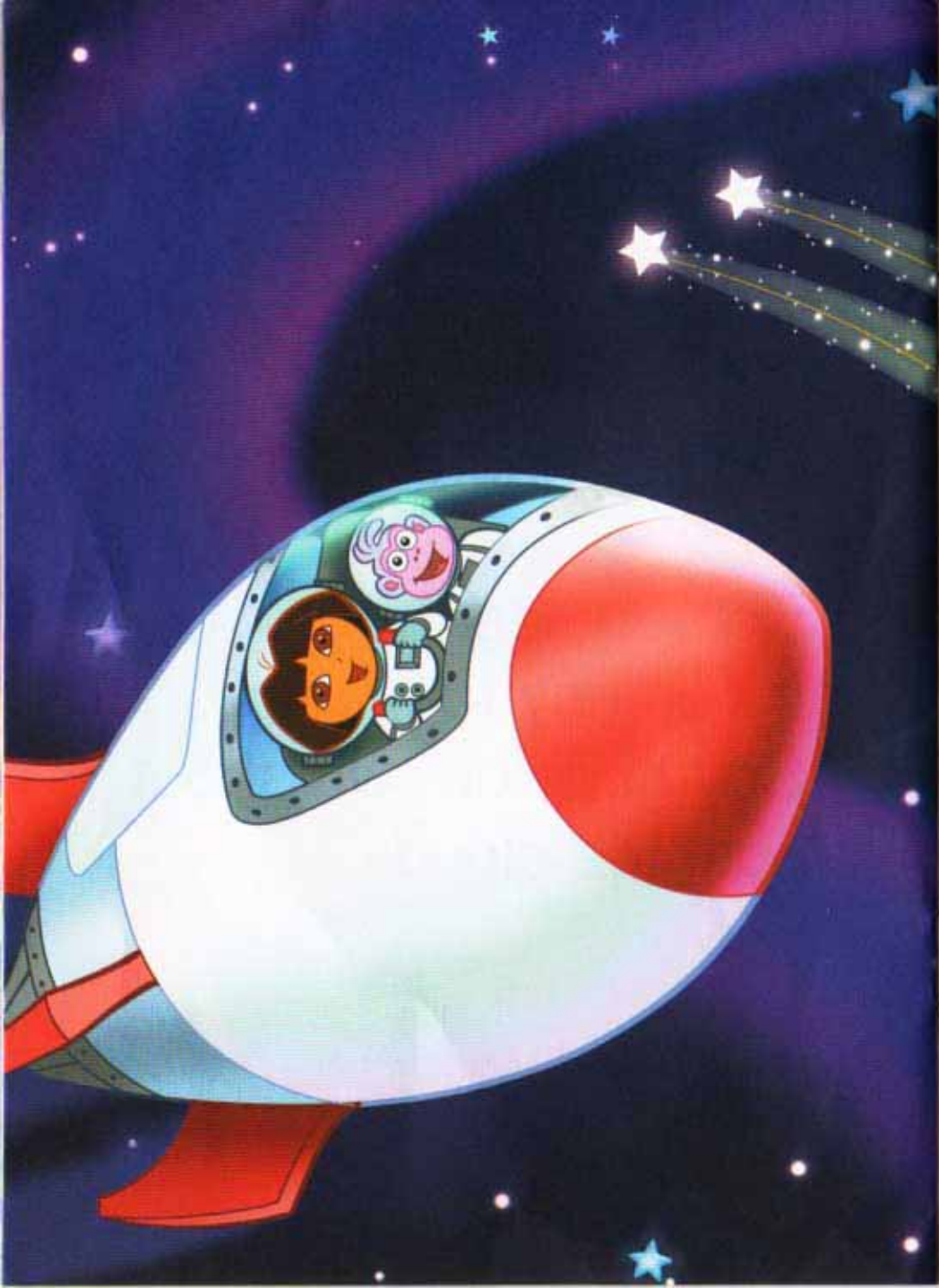
Before we go, we need to
