The bear is too big.



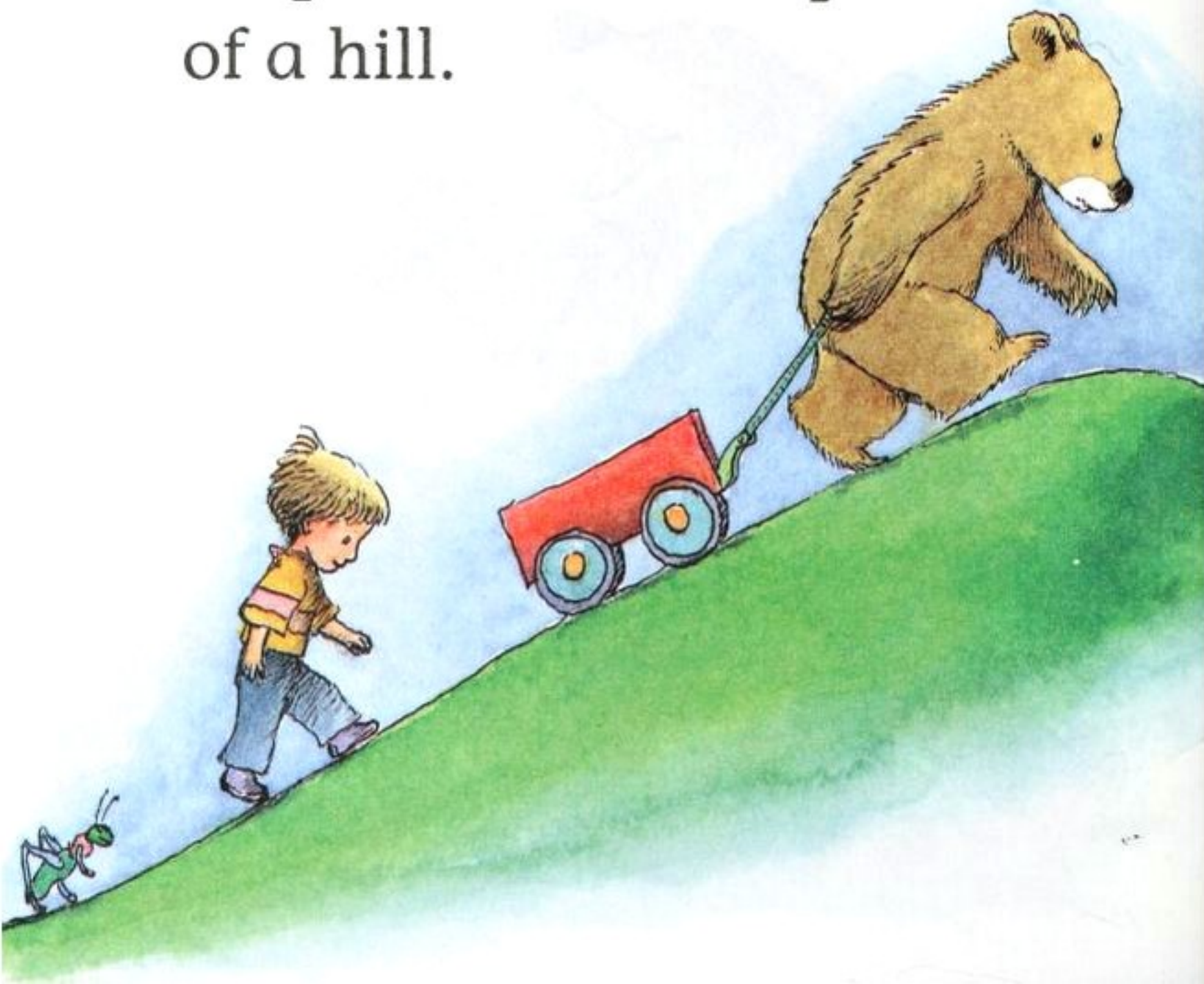
This time, the bug pulls

of a hill.

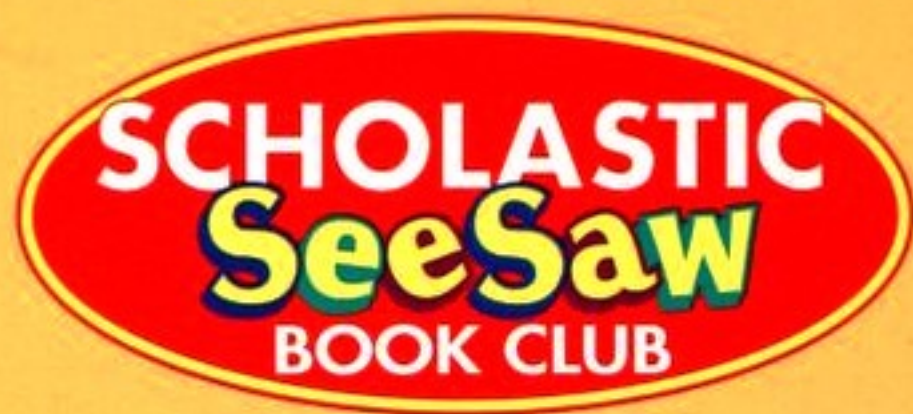


Then he gets back in.

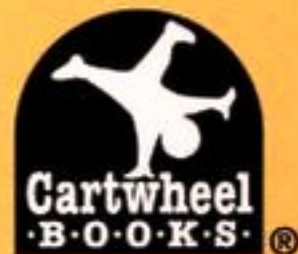
