
2. The First Noel

3. Away in a Manger







15. O Come, All Ye Faithful




O come, all ye faithful, Joyful and triumphant, O come ye, O come ye to Bethlehem. Come and behold him, Born the King of angels!

16. Joy to the World




Joy to the world! The Lord is come!

19. O Holy Night




